

## CRI Indoor Air Quality Carpet Testing Program

Julie Industries, Inc. is a participant in The Carpet and Rug Institute's Green Label Plus Indoor Air Quality Carpet Testing Program. The following StaticSmart ESD Carpet Tile styles; Discovery Series Carpet Tile, Frontier Series Carpet Tile, Conquest Series Carpet Tile, Presidential Series Carpet Tile and SMT Line Carpet Tile, LAN 4.0, LAN 1.0, LAN 4.1 and Colonial Series, meet the requirements of the Testing Program. Their certification number is as follows:

### #GLP 8185

The following is a list of the emission rate limits set for inclusion in the Program:

Item	Program Criteria
Total Volatile Organic Compounds	0.50 mg/m <sup>2</sup> hr
4-PC (4-Phenylcyclohexene)	0.05 mg/m <sup>2</sup> hr
Formaldehyde (to prove that none is used)	0.05 mg/m <sup>2</sup> hr
Styrene	0.40 mg/m <sup>2</sup> hr

Please note that carpet is not a source of formaldehyde. A note about CRI's Green Label Plus Testing Program: Green Label Plus meets, and even exceeds, California's indoor quality standards for low emitting products used in commercial settings such as schools and office buildings. To receive Green Label Plus certification, carpet and adhesive products must undergo a 14- day testing process, as required by Section 01350 guidelines, that measures emissions for a range of chemicals and is administered by an independent laboratory. The test methodology for small scale environmental chamber testing was developed in cooperation with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).
